Stoney Trail Expansion Project

Construction is underway throughout the Project with current estimates for completion and opening to traffic scheduled for late 2008, subject to favorable weather conditions.

At this time, the Transportation and Utility Corridor (TUC) is a construction zone with many hazards. Please advise all household members, including children, that the entire construction area is not a recreational area and should be avoided at all times.

We are pleased to announce that the Beddington Trail Interchange will now be constructed as part of this project. This is a very positive announcement, and is welcomed by all. This means that when current work is complete Stoney Trail will be mostly free flow, with only two traffic lights over its 22 km length from Hwy 1 to Hwy 2.

The low bid for the Final Surfacing Contract was submitted by South Rock Ltd. This is the final contract to be let for the 15 km section of Stoney Trail from Country Hills Boulevard to CP Rail crossing (West of Hwy #2). We anticipate this work could commence as early as May.

Other ongoing contracts in this section include: East Grading Work (Top Notch Construction Ltd.); West Nose Creek Mainline Bridges (PCL); Shagannappi Tr. Fly-over (Concreate USL); Sarcee Trail Overpass (Concreate USL); and Country Hills Boulevard Overpass (Concreate USL)
