

UPDATE - 75th Ave / 14th St Traffic Trial

Hello CKE Residents.

On July 24th, Bob Cooper and Richard Emery met with Alderman Pincott and senior officials from the City's Transportation Department to understand and discuss the process for the 75th Ave / 14th St traffic trial. Below, you will find a calendar of events of what to expect between now and the end of October.

<u>Date</u>	<u>Event / Activity</u>
April 22	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Traffic trial began
Mid September	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ City Transportation will conduct a 1-day (mid week) 8-hour traffic count
Mid September	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ City Transportation will conduct a 1-day (mid week) vehicle license survey on 75th Ave near 14th St to determine who is using the intersection
Mid September	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ City Transportation will conduct a 1-day (mid week) traffic survey to measure intersection travel times
Late September	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Statistical results of the traffic surveys & counts will be mailed to all CKE residents including the 3-schools.▪ Included in the mail out will be a simple, 1-page survey that is jointly from both City Transportation & CKE CA that will have a handful of questions to solicit feedback from CKE residents on the existing trial▪ Respondents will have ~2-weeks to return their completed survey's
Mid October	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ City Transportation & CKE CA will meet to review and analyze the results and to collectively determine how best to move forward
Late October	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ City Transportation & CKE CA will communicate survey results and decision for the intersection to all CKE residents (<i>probably by e-mail and our website?</i>)
October 22	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Traffic trial ends (give or take a day or 2)▪ The current trial will revert back to the old configuration if the consensus from the household survey and city transportation & CKE CA both agree that there is strong support for the intersection to revert back.▪ If the feedback from residents is that they generally endorse the trial, the existing configuration will remain in place until next spring at which time, permanent changes will be put in place.

It is really important to note the bullet points beside the October 22nd date. Every CKE household will have an equal opportunity to have a say in the final decision for this intersection. This joint survey from the City Transportation Dept and the CKE CA is your formal opportunity to express your opinions on this trial. When you get your package, please complete and return the survey, as your opinion really does matter.
